## Article 19. MISU Advisory Committee

- 19.1 There shall be a committee known as the Mary Immaculate Students' Union (MISU) Advisory Committee, herein after referred to as the Advisory Committee.
- 19.2 The purpose of the MISU Advisory Committee shall be twofold;
  - 19.2.1 to provide advice and guidance to the MISU President and Vice-President (Sabbaticals), and the General Manager on a range of strategic, management, operational, and corporate governance issues in relation to the MISU Advocacy and Representational Services
  - 19.2.2 to be the Board of Directors for the MISU Commercial Services Designated Activity Company (DAC)
- 19.3 The role and responsibilities of the Advisory Committee / DAC Board of Directors is outlined in the Terms of Reference, which is attached at schedule eight of this constitution.
- 19.4 It shall be the responsibility of the Union Council to ratify collectively the external nominations for membership of the Advisory Committee.
- 19.5 Nominations for membership of the Advisory Committee shall be submitted to the Union Council by the President in consultation with the General Manager.
- 19.6 The President in consultation with the General Manager shall report back to the Union Council on the work of the Advisory Committee on an annual basis.
