

Article 19. MISU Advisory Committee

19.1 There shall be a committee known as the Mary Immaculate Students' Union (MISU) Advisory Committee, herein after referred to as the Advisory Committee.

19.2 The purpose of the MISU Advisory Committee shall be twofold;

19.2.1 to provide advice and guidance to the MISU President and Vice-President (Sabbaticals), and the General Manager on a range of strategic, management, operational, and corporate governance issues in relation to the MISU Advocacy and Representational Services

19.2.2 to be the Board of Directors for the MISU Commercial Services Designated Activity Company (DAC)

19.3 The role and responsibilities of the Advisory Committee / DAC Board of Directors is outlined in the Terms of Reference, which is attached at schedule eight of this constitution.

19.4 It shall be the responsibility of the Union Council to ratify collectively the external nominations for membership of the Advisory Committee.

19.5 Nominations for membership of the Advisory Committee shall be submitted to the Union Council by the President in consultation with the General Manager.

19.6 The President in consultation with the General Manager shall report back to the Union Council on the work of the Advisory Committee on an annual basis.
