## 1. Welcome and Apologies

The President welcomed everyone at 1pm and announced that the newly elected Post Graduate Officer will be joining the next committee meeting. Apologies were noted.

## 2. Unapproved Minutes

The VPSEW proposed the unapproved minutes from the last meeting and the Thurles Officer seconded with noted amendments.

#### 3. Matters Arising

<u>Gaeltacht Fees Next Steps</u> – The next agreed step after presenting this issue to the Teaching Council is informing students the approach that the union will take in advocating for Thurles students. The approach is either the council would make attending the Gaeltacht a requirement for Post Primary students or for the college to fund part of the fees. Students will be emailed to this effect, before the meeting with the Head of School for Thurles scheduled for Monday, 13 November, 2023.

<u>Thurles Ball</u> – About 31 tickets for the ball have been sold so far. The President urged all exec members to continue promoting the Thurles Ball slated for Tuesday (14 November) at Hayes Hotel. Some students have expressed concern over the price for attending the ball. The President explained that the price was settled for to account for all costs of organising the event. Initially, the price would have been below €55.

<u>UGM</u> – the next Union General Meeting will be held on Thursday (16 November) at 6pm in the Student's Lounge (in Thurles) and in either the MISU Meeting Room or a lecture theatre (in Limerick). The VPA called on all exec members to prepare their reports, ahead of the UGM.

<u>Pride Week Update</u> – There will be no night event in Thurles during this week because the week comes before the ball. However, other activities will go as planned. In Limerick, the Pride and Pleasure Quick planned for Monday (6 November) will go ahead. About 5 tickets for the quiz have been sold so far. The VPSEW urged exec members to promote the quiz to students to boost attendance.

<u>Class Rep Social Event</u> – the Limerick event will be held on Monday (6 November) 6pm at Level Up, while the Thurles event will be held on Wednesday (8 November) after Union Council

<u>Exec Weekly Reports</u> – the President reminded all exec members to share their weekly reports with the VPA for minute purposes.

<u>Thurles Vendor Update</u> – Students have requested having hair and beauty vendors on campus during Christmas market in Thurles.

<u>Comms & Services Updates</u> – the Comms & Services department has planned various events in November and December. Some of them include the Pride and Pleasure Quiz in Limerick (Monday, 6 November) and the Swap Shop in Thurles (Wednesday, 8 November).
