## **Executive Committee Meeting Minutes**

## 1. Welcome and Apologies

The President welcomed everyone and called meeting to order at 1pm.

## 2. Unapproved Minutes

The VPSEW proposed the unapproved minutes from the last meeting and the Thurles Officer seconded.

## 3. Matters Arising

- i) New Thurles Ball Date The President noted that the venue for the ball was not available on 14 November and wondered if the 15 November would work instead. The new proposed date could not work as fourth years have presentations on that day. It was noted that students were eagerly waiting for confirmation of the date as soon as next week. The President will report back to the comms and services department.
- ii) Teaching Council Update The Teaching Council visited the college on Monday (in Limerick) and Tuesday (in Thurles). Council officials met students, staff and some union officers. The VPSEW described the meeting between the officials and students in Limerick as constructive. In the meeting, limerick students, who were class reps recruited by the union, raised concerns over placement, tutors, Gaeltacht, and lack of communication with the college. Both the VPSEW and the VPA were present at the meeting. In Thurles, no union member attended the meeting between the teaching council and students. However, when council officials visited the student's union office, the Thurles Officer called on them to look into Gaeltacht fees for students. The officers appeared receptive.
- iii) <u>Gaeltacht Fees</u> this issue was presented to the Teaching Council and the exec will follow up.
- iv) Upcoming Events -
  - Halloween Games: the games will be held on both campuses next Tuesday
    (31 October). The VPA will co-ordinate games in Limerick between 1pm and

3pm, while the VPSEW together with the Thurles Officer will co-ordinator those in Thurles between 12pm and 2pm. Students will play different games, including Monopoly and 30 Seconds. 30 Seconds was donated by Fuzion Communication, a Dublin-based PR firm.

- Pride Week: the VPSEW is finalising the schedule for this week with the coms and services department. The officer is also in touch with Tipperary Pride for them to participate in the week. During Pride Week, contraception will be offered to students on both campuses, and social media videos with "Happy Pride Week" messages will be produced.
- Christmas Week: It was suggested that the Christmas Daze in Thurles be held on 29 November. It was noted Finn should be kept updated on the Christmas Daze. The need to find out the suitable date for the daze from students in Limerick was also noted.
- The President announced that the coms department has planned other events for Thurles. The executive committee approved them, but the Thurles Officer pointed out that officers should be given a heads up that events were being planned. The planned events are:
