1. Welcome and Apologies

The President welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 1pm.

2. Unapproved Minutes

The VP Academic proposed the unapproved minutes from the last meeting and the Thurles Officer seconded.

3. Matters Arising

- i) <u>Thurles Mature Students' Coffee Morning</u> The Thurles Officer held the first coffee morning for mature students on Tuesday (26 September). The event was successful, although attendance was low. About five (5) students showed up for the coffee morning. This was mainly due to fourth years having an optional lecture at the time of the event. The Thurles Officer is looking for another time to host the next coffee morning.
- ii) <u>PME Student Roll List –</u> Some second year PME students were removed from the roll list (class e-mailing list) in Week 1 due to non-payment of tuition fees. The VPA presented this case to the PME Course Board on Wednesday (20 September), but was told that the move was simply standard procedure, not an act of excluding any student. All affected students should settle the matter with Student Fees, who could put them on temporary registration, and the roll list would then be updated.
- iii) <u>Exec SharePoint –</u> The VPSEW advised exec members to log into SharePoint using student e-mail addresses as opposed to personal or office addresses. This came after exec members were having difficulties logging into the SharePoint. The VPSEW will send the direct link to the SharePoint site on WhatsApp and will explain the process of logging into the site in the next Exec Committee.
- iv) <u>Limerick Mature Student WhatsApp Group –</u> The EDI Officer will create the group after hosting a coffee morning for mature students. The coffee morning in Limerick is

scheduled to take place in two weeks' time.

v) <u>Thurles Canteen Contacts</u> – The President will follow up this issue and contact management of the canteen at Thurles campus. It was noted that some students on the campus are happy with the recently reduced prices of food in the canteen, while others are not. The Thurles Officer stressed that more work still needs to be done on the prices.

- a) <u>Class Rep Update</u>

- The VPA urged exec members to help push nomination for more first years through class addresses and student-to-student interactions
- The VPA also tanked the exec for working hard in the recruitment of the reps on both campuses

b) <u>Union Council Update</u>

- The first Union Council meeting was scheduled to take place at 5pm on the day of this exec committee meeting
- Before the council meeting, class rep training was set occur on both campuses at 4pm
- About 15 class reps (i.e. 10 in Limerick and 5 in Thurles) were expected to attend both training and Union Council that evening.

- The UGM which was due to take place on Thursday (28 September) at 5pm was cancelled. Sabbats are yet to agree on new dates and times for the union general meeting.
